Age Categories: 5-7 8-10 11-14 Family/Group (working together)

- Completed art projects must be submitted to KALB no later than Friday, July 15th at 4:00 p.m.
- Take photos as you collect items, as you create the artwork, and photos or video of the
 completed project. We want to see the artist(s) at work! Photos and videos may be
 emailed to: EarthyArt2020@gmail.com Be sure to include project name and adult
 contact information.
- If the items used in the artwork are perishable, take good photos to submit as your entry. Artwork must be 3D and a photo will only be accepted if the artwork is perishable.
- Items may be painted, embellishments may be added such as lettering and other items that fit the artwork theme.
- Adults may help; however, the majority of the work should be done by student(s).
- If you have children of various ages in your family or you have a group that wants to work on a project together, they should be entered into the "Family/Group" category.
- Projects will be judged on creativity, photos taken through the process, and story details provided on the Entry Form.
- Be creative! Keep it "Earthy"! Enjoy the beauty of nature along the way!

PRIZES: A total of \$700 in prize money is available to be awarded. The following prizes will be awarded in each age category:

1st Place: \$100

2nd Place: \$50

3rd Place: \$25
